School will:

1. Provide the best possible learning environment that is safe, attractive and caring;

3. Be committed to, and have high expectations of your child's behaviour and learning;
4. Offer a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child;
5. Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your child's learning; such as residential trips and music concerts;
6. Welcome parents/carers into the life of the school and ensure that teaching staff are available by arrangement to discuss any concerns you might have about your child;
7. Create an atmosphere of care and respect, seeking to enable every member of the school community to feel valued;
8. Keep you informed about the school curriculum, policies, initiatives and events which affect your child;
9. Set homework tasks that consolidate or stimulate learning.

At home I/we will:
